
#### Chair's welcome

## Ways you can leave a gift in your will

There are several ways that you can leave a gift to The Roman Baths Foundation. After your loved ones are taken care of, kindly consider leaving a percentage of your estate to The Roman Baths Foundation. Even a small percentage, like 1%, can make a significant impact. If you leave a gift in your will you may be able to reduce the Inheritance Tax liability of your estate. Please seek legal and/or financial advice.



#### A share of your estate

You can leave a percentage of what's left of your estate after your other wishes are carried out (a residuary gift). This type of legacy has the greatest value and impact.



#### A fixed amount

You can give a fixed financial donation (a pecuniary gift). The value of this gift will go down over time as inflation increases. It is possible to index link the sum of money to preserve its value despite inflation. Your solicitor will be able to advise you on this.



#### Amend your current will

There are ways to amend your existing will to update your wishes. Your solicitor can advise you how to do this.


